## Ontario Art Therapy Association Retired Membership Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for the Ontario Art Therapy Association's Retired Status, one must:

- Be a Registered or Professional Member, in good standing, with the OATA
- Be at least fifty-five (55) years of age
- Be no longer engaged in the active\* practice of art therapy

\*The OATA defines active practice as more than 120 hours of work per year in art therapy related activities, such as supervision, teaching and clinical practice.

### Benefits

- Retired Members of the Ontario Art Therapy Association, shall:
- Be voting members, but not eligible to hold office
- Be entitled to OATA membership benefits
- Maintain their designation of OATR (only if Registered)

### Requirements

Retired members will be required to:

- Renew their membership annually, and pay the membership fees as determined by the Board.
- To apply to the Board in the event that they wish to return to their previous Professional or Registered Status. Such cases will be given individual consideration.
